## The Bar Association Criteria for the Selection of Evaluators

### 2003/04 Panels

1. The desirability of at least 7 years experience as a legal practitioner.
2. Demonstrated regular provision of advice and/or appearance in the area of specialisation.
3. High degree of competence in the said area.
4. Good repute in manner, demeanour and presence.
5. Demonstrated understanding of the evaluation process.
6. A person who applies for inclusion on the list ("the applicant") is required to be, and whilst on the list to remain, the holder of a practising certificate issued by the New South Wales Bar Association, and to be a current member of the New South Wales Bar Association.
7. Recommendations for Appointment to the court lists are solely at the discretion of Bar Council.
