About the workshop

The LEADR Mediation Workshop introduces participants to the theory and practical skills of mediation through lectures, demonstrations and simulated mediations. On the final day of the workshop each participant is given individual feedback and encouragement by an experienced mediator.

The workshop aims to:

- discuss different approaches to dispute resolution
- instruct in mediation process and its philosophy
- improve communication skills to enable participants to be effective mediators
- highlight barriers to effective communication
- identify disputes suitable for mediation
- develop strategy and preparation skills for those representing clients in mediation
- encourage participants to practise these skills in at least six simulated mediations
- discuss ethical dilemmas
- provide training aspect required for LEADR accreditation.

Who should attend?

The workshop is designed for people involved in disputes whether as participant, adviser or resolver or firms interested in incorporating dispute resolution procedures into their professional services and management. Over the last ten years LEADR has trained teachers, managers, dentists, doctors, lawyers, accountants, administrators, students, public servants... - in fact participants consistently report that the workshop provides essential life skills for everyone.

A maximum of 30 people will be accepted into each workshop. Places are often in demand. Early registration is recommended.

About the trainers

TANIA SOURDIN - Professor in Law and Dispute Resolution, La Trobe, Director Centre for the study of the Legal Profession.

Professor Sourdin is an experienced mediator, conciliator and adjudicator.

Tania Sourdin has conducted organisational change workshops and has facilitated change processes involving over 400 staff. She has developed and managed a number of professional education programs in the ADR area and has trained a range of professionals (including judges, doctors, barristers and business people) in communication, advocacy and dispute resolution skills. Her skills in managing organisational change and facilitating workshops are consistently rated as excellent.

Professor Sourdin has been the author of a number of publications relating to ADR and was the principal author of the Australian Law Reform Commission Issues Paper relating to ADR (1998).

She has a PhD in commercial dispute resolution and has presented numerous papers at conferences in the area of ADR. She has conducted evaluation research into dispute resolution processes in seven Courts and Tribunals and is currently commissioned as an independent reviewer to evaluate processes in other organisations.

NINA HARDING - is a professional dispute resolver and trainer. She has been recognised as one of Australia's premier trainers for the past 10 years.

In addition to training mediators and other dispute resolvers, Nina has been the facilitator in many large public disputes and has regularly been called on by government and the private sector to assist in community disputes. Nina has mediated in matters where claims have exceeded \$2 million.

Nina has travelled extensively sharing her knowledge. She has trained Judges in Asia, delivered papers at international conferences and trained in all major Australian cities. Her particular expertise as a practitioner centres on community facilitation, where she is a leader in the field.

BRADLEY CHENOWETH - has a Bachelor of Laws degree from the Australian National University, myriad ADR training qualifications and is also a certificate 4 Workplace trainer.

Bradley has worked professionally in ADR for approaching 9 years both as a trainer and a mediator / facilitator.
